Safe Routes to Schools Improvement Plan

Site Assessment held May 2016



Valley Ave. Bicycle Route

- Narrow road lanes to install Class II bicycle lane.
- Long-term: install separated Class I bicycle path.



-Install yield sign to alert drivers of pedestrians.

-Trim the existing tree at the median.

-Add yield teeth.

-Construct a median regue island.

Northway Rd. Crossings

- Install high visibility crosswalks to improve pedestrian visibility and discourage cars from blocking crosswalks.

- Long-term: reconstruct the whole intersection.



Northway Rd. Parking Restriction

Prohibit parking from 12:00 PM-3:00PM on the north segment of Northway Rd. to prevent back-up for cars turning right.



Greenwood Rd. Bicycle Route

Consider adding a Class III bicycle route with sharrows on Greenwood Rd. to serve high volume of bicyclists and connect with existing bicycle route on Valley Ave.



Greenwood Rd. Loading Zone

Consider designating a segment of Greenwood Rd. as a loading zone and adding a new gate to improve circulation around the school.



Greenwood Dr. / Alameda Dr. Intersection

- Install a high visibility crosswalk to improve pedestrian visibility.

- Consider installing a traffic circle (12 ft. diameter) to manage U-turns and calm traffic.

Parking Lot Circulation 8

Straighten the striping to prevent double parking in the drop-off lane.



Parking Lot Loading Zones

Re-stripe curb to clarify designated loading areas.



Greenwood Rd. / Valley Ave. Curb Extensions

- Install curb extensions to provide additional pedestrian space and to slow turning vehicles.

- Install countdown signals for crossing pedestrians on Valley Ave.
