DRAFT Parkmont Elementary School

Improvement Concepts

1 Parkmont Elementary entrance on Parkside Drive

- Coordinate with proposed multipurpose room construction to construct covered bicycle parking on school property
- Continue to encourage parents to use recommended student loading ciculation pattern by providing map and information at start of school year and at new parent orientation

2 Parkside Drive at Acacia Street

- Sign and stripe 20 feet of red curb on the northeast corner of Acacia Street
- Install truncated domes at northeast and southeast curb ramps
- Restripe existing transverse crosswalk on east leg of Parkside Drive with high-visibility ladder crosswalk
- Trim vegetation on eastbound approach to maintain visibility
- Work with with parents to assist students crossing at this intersection

3 Parkside Drive, Bronson Street to Acacia Street - Sign Parkside Drive as Class III Bike Route

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Consider speed lumps to reduce vehicular speeds and discourage cut-through traffic, pending 70% approval by fronting residents

4 Parkside Drive at Country Drive

- Construct bulb-out on southwest corner to improve visibility of pedestrians
- Install truncated domes at southeast and southwest curb ramps
- Trim vegetation on eastbound approach to maintain visibility
- Work with with parents to assist students crossing at this intersection

6 Parkside Drive, Country Drive to Mowry Avenue

- Install truncated domes at curb ramps at north side of intersection
- Sign Parkside Drive as Class III Bike Route
- Consider speed lumps to reduce vehicular speeds and discourage cut-through traffic, pending 70% approval by fronting residents

6 Mowry Avenue Mid-Block Crosswalk at Fremont BART driveway

- Consider Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon to improve yielding compliance
- Consider reconstructing east corner to reduce curb radii and provide additional pedestrian space
- Consider signalization

Peralta Boulevard Mid-Block Crossing at Acacia Court

- Install curb ramp with truncated domes on north side of Acacia Court at trail access
- Conduct student crossing counts to support potential SR2S infrastructure improvement grant application for sidewalks and other improvements on Peralta Boulevard
- Pursue improvements to Peralta Boulevard with Caltrans: curb, gutter, sidewalk, potentially curb bulb-outs at marked crosswalk
- Encourage developer of vacant parcel to provide trail access from Acacia Court or from Peralta Boulevard to Acacia Street

Other Recommendations

- Consider park and walk from park east of the school
