

Reach Academy Elementary Improvement Plan

Reach Academy entrance

- Paint 200-foot long white drop-off zone, eliminating approximately 12 parking spaces. Parking inventory shows that parking demand can be accomodated on Sunnyside Street and 99th Avenue.

- Paint 20-foot long blue handicap zone after existing curb ramp at Warner Avenue pedestrian crossing.

- Establish student valet program to expedite loading.

- Create informational materials to send home with students explaining new loading zone.

- Work with Oakland Police Department to provide targeted enforcement during school commute hours, particularly related to double-parking and blocking the bike lane.

Bancroft Avenue at 98th Avenue

- Repair pedestrian signal for eastbound crossing.

- Consider a Leading Pedestrian Interval (LPI) for southbound pedestrians crossing 98th Avenue.

- Consider prohibiting right turns on red for southbound vehicles turning right onto 98th Avenue.

Consider prohibiting U-turns for northbound Bancroft Avenue vehicles.
 Study feasibility of adding crossing guard.

98th Avenue

Install speed feedback signs on 98th Avenue east of Sunnyside Street uncontrolled crossing and west of Cherry Street uncontrolled crossing.
Consider organizing a walking school bus program for students living northwest of Reach Academy.

Bancroft Avenue

- Install bike lane sign on Bancroft Avenue.

- Refresh bike lanes on Bancroft Avenue between 97th and 99th Avenues.

Bancroft Avenue at Warner Avenue

 Add Assembly B signs in median at uncontrolled crossing at Warner Avenue.
 Consider additional treatments to enhance motorist awareness of pedestrians in crosswalk (e.g., pedestrian-actuated flashing beacon, curb extensions).
