Non-infrastructure Recommendations

- Consider encouraging/facilitating carpooling
- Send parents/guardians regular reminders showing where the drop off areas are including all of the rules/policies in place
- Encourage parents to wait a few minutes later than usual to pickup their child to reduce congestion
- Direct parents to use one of the two parking lot drop off zones, dependent on how they access the school: Boca Raton drivers use the South Lot, drivers using South Gate or Holly Hill use the North Lot

Safe Routes to Schools Improvement Plan

Site Assessment held March 2017

- Southgate Street / Holly Hill Avenue Resurface existing path connecting Southgate Street to Southgate Park
- Install pedestrian-scale lighting along path
 Install curb extensions at the southwest and southeast corners
- Install high visibility crosswalks at southwest and southeast legs
- Install advance yield markings at southwest and northeast legs
- Install advance stop bar at southeast leg

School Parking Lot at North End of Holly Hill Avenue

- Convert parking lot to one way circulation (south driveway in, north driveway out)
- Stripe a line and arrows to create two lanes: a loading/ unloading lane on the right and a through
- lane for cars to pull out into on the left Place appropriate signage for one way circulation and drop-off / pick-up procedures
- Holly Hill Avenue Curb at School Frontage Install 20' lengths of red curb and R26S signage (No Parking Any Time) where shown to increase driveway visibility
- Install green 15-minute-parking curb with associated
- Install green is initial green between driveways as shown
 Install white curb and R25D signs (Loading and unloading only 7AM-4PM) where shown
 Install "Pull Forward" Signage along entire school

- Install curb extension at northwest corner of Holly Hill/Palatka
- Use on-street parking pavement markings to indicate parking stalls to increase compliance
- Install red curb around all crosswalks

- Holly Hill Avenue / Boca Raton Street Install R2-6aP sign (Fines Double) for northbound traffic
- Prohibit drop-offs in the parking lot to the northeast of the intersection (staff and buses only)
- Install cones at parking lot driveway to block access from Boca Raton Street - Install red curb around all crosswalks

Sleepy Hollow Avenue / Boca Raton Street - Consider discussing with AC Transit modifying Route

- 97. One suggestion could be to deviate the route slightly along Sleepy Hollow to provide the students with a closer/ more convenient stop.
- Install red curb around crosswalks



Calaroga Avenue School Access Point - Consider opening the gate to allow direct access for students coming from the east; currently students walking or biking from that direction are forced into significant out-of-direction travel to reach the school.









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
