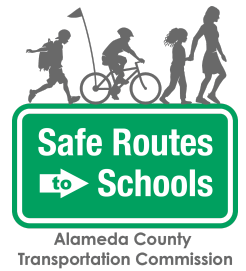


Ongoing Walk and Roll March
