Frequently Asked Questions

Does every school in Alameda County participate in this event?

No, only schools who are registered for the Alameda County Safe Routes to Schools program are able to participate. Over 295 elementary, middle, and high schools are registered in the program. Of those schools, elementary and middle schools opt in to participating in the <u>Golden Sneaker Contest</u>. High schoolers may opt to participate in the <u>Reboot Your Commute</u> event
