- When: Thursday, May 15, 2025
- Where: Participating elementary and middle schools in Alameda County
- Why: To encourage students to use active modes of transportation for healthy kids, safer streets, and strong communities

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Does every school in Alameda County participate in this event?

No, only schools that are registered for the Alameda County Safe Routes to Schools Program are eligible to participate. Over 310 elementary, middle, and high schools are registered in the Program. Of those schools, elementary and middle schools opt in to participating in Bike to School Day.

#### Which schools are participating in Bike to School Day?
